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2-Way Radio Mounting Options

I looked at the enclosure manual; but I'm still not 100% sure what I need to do to make this work.

See the attached image.

What I'm trying to do.. is make a face plate with a rectangle cutout that a CB radio will slide into. The radio has two holes/screws.. one on each side, midway down to secure it to the mounting bracket. Basically I need to make a piece that will attach at a 90 degree angle at the edge of the rectangle cutout on each side of where the radio will mount, to give me a place to put the screw (again, see image attached).

What all do I need to do in the front panel designer to make this work? Just put a blind hole near the cutout? What about hardware, and the actual bracket? Assume it would need to be a bent, or welded L type bracket with a hole to mount?
